ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT 101

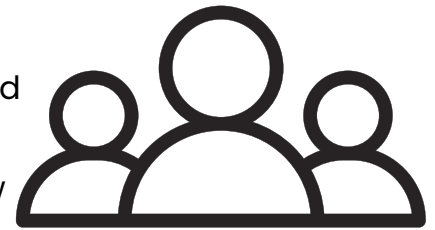
WHAT IS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Economic development is about helping a community grow stronger by supporting local businesses, attracting new investments, and creating good jobs. It means building opportunities for residents, improving the local quality of life, and making Port Arthur a place where people want to live, work, and thrive.



THE PORT ARTHUR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The Port Arthur Economic Development Corporation is a **Type A** corporation created to enhance Port Arthur's business climate and overall economic development. The PAEDC is responsible for encouraging and developing business growth and attracting new business to Port Arthur.



HOW A TEXAS TYPE A EDC FUNCTIONS

In Texas, an Economic Development Corporation (EDC) is a nonprofit created by local voters to grow jobs and strengthen the economy. Funded by a portion of city sales tax, an EDC reinvests those dollars into projects that benefit the community.

There are two types of EDCs: **Type A** EDC's and **Type B** EDC's.

Texas Type A EDC can do but are not limited to the following:

- Support the creation or retention of primary jobs in industries such as: manufacturing, warehousing, distribution, and industrial facilities.
- Fund infrastructure that promotes or develops new and/or expanded business development.
- Provide job training programs that benefit industries contributing to primary job creation.
- Facilitate the relocation or expansion of businesses that create primary jobs.
- Invest in research and development projects aimed at innovation and technological advancement.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be able to read and speak the English language to converse with the general public and make entries on reports and records.
- Must successfully complete a DOT Physical Examination and Drug Screen within 30 days of the class start date. (not not included in tuition)
- Must have a valid Texas Drivers License.

Applicants must provide their three year driving record specific - Type 2

Must be within 30 days of class start date.
